








TurningPoint™ Audience Response System (ARS) Quick Start Guide

Caution:	The TurningPoint receiver and clickers will not work from PowerPoint.																													
1. Open a presentation	<p>TurningPoint presentations must be opened from within the TurningPoint software.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. DOUBLE CLICK on the TurningPoint 2006 icon located on the desktop. B. SELECT Open, from the File menu to open your presentation. 																													
2. Reset Defaults	<p>Resetting the defaults will ensure the receiver is properly set up to receive responses,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. SELECT the  Response Device Wizard icon from the TurningPoint menu in PowerPoint. B. SELECT the Restart Wizard button. C. SELECT the Next button. D. SELECT the Next button, again. E. SELECT the Cancel button. F. SELECT the Next button to display the Please set keypad range(s) screen. 																													
3. Check Settings	<p>Check the settings to make sure all the clicker responses will be recorded.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Starting device number should be at 1 B. Ending device number should be >200 C. Channel should be set at 41 D. SELECT the Next button to display the Start the polling test or finish screen. 																													
4. Run a Polling Test	<p>Running a polling test of the clickers and receiver operation will ensure a successful presentation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. SELECT the Start Test button B. SELECT any number on the keypad of at least six keypads for a complete test <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. If all six responses display (as shown on the right) the system is ready to use. C. SELECT the End Test button D.
