Laptop Requirements

All students are required to have a laptop computer. A laptop is necessary for activities that will take place in the Pharmacy Skills Lab.

Pharmacy Technician License

All students must possess and maintain an active Illinois Pharmacy Technician license. If you have not already done so, you must complete an application for Pharmacy Technician registration as a Student Pharmacist before beginning Introductory Pharmacy Practice Experiences (IPPEs) in the first year of the program. Immunizations

Rosalind Franklin University promotes students' health by requiring a health history and proof of current immunizations prior to matriculation into our clinical programs. All students are required to complete an **Immunization Form** and a **Health History Form** prior to matriculation. Criminal Background Check

Our offer of acceptance is contingent upon passing the mandatory criminal background check. Criminal background checks (CBC) protect the safety of students, faculty, staff and patients and are a requirement for matriculation to RFUMS. You will be able to complete your entire CBC process online. You will receive an email from Certiphi approximately 60 days prior to your program start date with instructions on how to proceed. You will receive a copy of the same results that are sent to RFUMS, and you will be contacted only if the results warrant further discussion or action. Your CBC will remain confidential, and your permanent student record will only indicate that you successfully completed this matriculation requirement. All students who have not had their criminal background check completed by matriculation will be considered "provisionally matriculated" until the criminal background results are reviewed by Rosalind Franklin University.

Transcripts
