Goal 1: Educational Excellence

The College shall foster a premier interprofessional learning environment for the education and development of competent, innovative, and compassionate healthcare professionals.

- 1.1 Expand and continue to integrate interprofessional education experiences for CHP students.
- 1.2 Advance the College's strength and distinctiveness in clinical rotations.
- 1.3 Identify, embrace and utilize effective and innovative educational tools and models.
- 1.4 Strategically develop new programs consistent with the mission and vision of the college.
- 1.5 Advance and integrate educational initiatives that foster and promote multicultural awareness in the classroom, the workplace, and at the bedside.

Goal 2: Faculty Development

The College shall offer its faculty excellent opportunities to grow in knowledge and skills, and shall assist them in the advancement of their careers as medical educators.

- 2.1 Expand the number and types of faculty development seminars available to CHP faculty.
- 2.2 Identify opportunities for faculty to obtain advanced degrees.
- 2.3 Develop new degree programs or fellowships that will increase scholarly activity and teaching effectiveness within the College.
- 2.4 Develop systems to assist faculty in reaching promotion and tenure goals.

Goal 3: Scholarship

The College shall promote and expand scholarship, in all its forms, among the faculty and students.

- 3.1 Cultivate collaborations that lead to new sources of research support.
- 3.2 Participate in research institutes established by the University that complement the strengths of the College.
- 3.3 Provide opportunities to enhance active scholarly participation and publication by CHP faculty and students.

Goal 4: Outreach

The College shall engage its community and its alumni through partnerships, alliances, and collaborations.

- 4.1 Participate in a University academic pipeline that brings potential students to the campus and offers them chances to interact with our current students and faculty.
- 4.2 Expand our community service activities through new initiatives and new partnerships within the local community.
- 4.3 Continue to promote a spirit of volunteerism among students and faculty within the College.

Goal 5: Demonstration of Quality

The College shall be recognized for its dedication to the highest educational and professional standards.

- 5.1 Work with the Director of Assessment to design and promote a quality assessment and improvement program within the College.
- 5.2 Develop a comprehensive plan and infrastructure that recognizes, fosters and rewards quality.
- 5.3 Integrate the Datatel management system into College operations to increase productivity and efficiency.
- 5.4 Work with the Associate Dean for Student Affairs to enhance wellness and health promotion programs within the College.
- 5.5 Develop a new interprofessional health promotion events in the College.

Goal 6: Resource Responsibility

The College will invest in its faculty, staff, students and educational growth while maintaining a strong financial position and enhancing its revenue sources.

- 6.1 Allocate budgeted resources to support the key strategies of the College.
